Church Life Updates

- **February Mission Project:** This month, Calvary will be participating in the "Souper Bowl of Caring" by having a "Canned Soup Drive" to support the Food Bank run by Yokefellow Ministries. You'll find collection boxes in the sanctuary lobby, the elevator entrance, and the church office. Please help us "tackle hunger" by supporting and blessing our neighbors in need.
- Save Some Soles: Thanks to everyone who participated in our "Save Some Soles" Sock Drive. Because of your generosity, we collected 330 pairs of socks. And because some local business partners donated 570 pairs of socks to support our efforts, a total of 900 pairs of socks will soon be "warming the soles" of those in need.
- Ash Wednesday Worship: At 6 o'clock on Wednesday, February 14, there will be a brief Ash Wednesday service in the sanctuary to mark the start of Lent.
