- **Women in Mission** will meet at 9:00 AM this Tuesday, February 7, in the Fellowship Hall to make soup for our homebound members.
- **February’s Mission Project:** We’re inviting you to “Share the Love” by participating in Calvary’s 2nd Annual “Make Mount Airy Our Valentine” mission project. On Sunday, February 12, there will be boxes of cookies ready for you to deliver to local businesses as a way of blessing them and thanking them for serving our community. If you’d like to “share the love,” please sign-up using the registration form located on today’s bulletin tear-off.
- **“One Calvary” Sunday:** Our pastor and deacons have agreed that one important goal for our church in 2023 is to foster a deeper sense of connection among our members, regardless of which worship gathering they attend.
