A Special Word on Getting "Back to Church"

Next Sunday, February 21, the Calvary family will take a small step toward getting "Back to Church" by resuming our Pre-Coronavirus worship schedule. This means that our Uplift Contemporary worship gathering will take place at 8:30; Sunday School will take place at 9:45; our Traditional worship gathering will take place at 10:55; and childcare will be provided for the entire Sunday morning schedule.

Of course, COVID continues to be an issue in our community; and so, we recognize that some will choose to continue worshipping with us online. (Note: Both services will be live-streamed on Facebook.) For those who do worship in person, please help us safeguard everyone by continuing to practice social-distancing and by wearing masks when you are in the church facility.

Notes on Church Life

- **Cereal Drive:** Help us collect 500 boxes of cereal this month to feed hungry families. You can bring your donation to church on Sunday or drop it off at the church office during the week.
- **Community Meal:** This Wednesday (2/17), the Coed 1 class will host a "drive-thru" community meal, beginning around 6 PM. Please help us spread the word to those who might need a meal. Encourage those who do come to enter from the Calvary Drive side of our facility and drive around the back of the church to the covered entrance. Guests should remain in their vehicle. Limit of 4 meals per car.
- **Women's Bible Study:** *"Elijah: Faith and Fire,"* a new virtual Women's Bible study by Priscilla Shirer, will begin on Sunday, February 21. Study materials and access to the teaching sessions can be purchased directly from Lifeway. Contact Becky Critz or Kim Morrison for details.
- **Reallocating Gifts:** Calvary plans to reallocate some designated gifts that are "left over" from earlier projects. Gifts given to repair water damage in 2017 and to support a "Feed the Hunger" pack-a-thon in 2019 are no longer needed for those purposes. Therefore, we'd like to use these funds to repair new water damage in a sanctuary stairwell. If you contributed to either of these projects and **do not** want your gift to be reallocated, please contact the church office or a member of the Finance Committee no later than Monday, March 1.

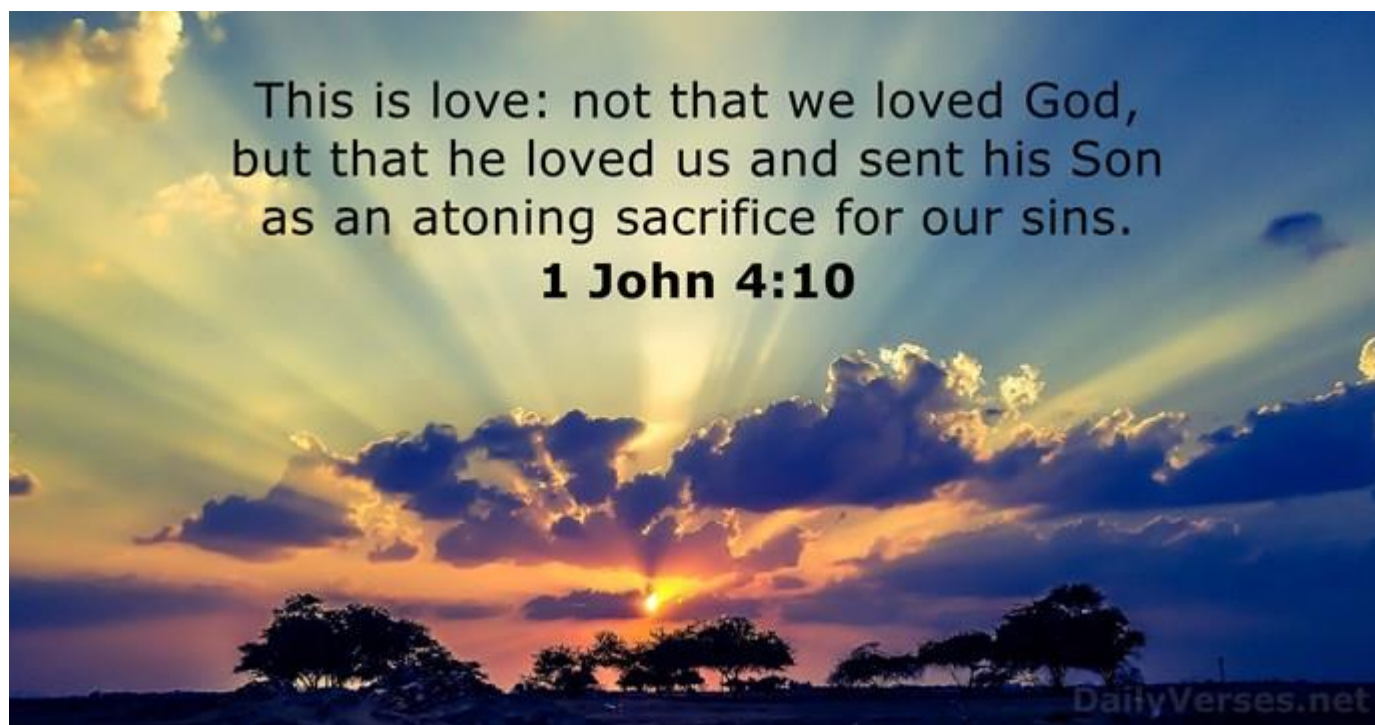
