Church Life Updates

- **Results for Yokefellow Cracker Drive:** Because of your faithfulness and generosity, we collected just over 450 boxes of crackers to help feed hungry families in our community. Thanks for being a blessing!
- **Midday Worship for Lent:** Calvary is joining First Baptist and First Presbyterian for a series of midday Lenten services. These services will be held every Wednesday at Noon and will rotate among all three churches. The brief time of worship and reflection will be followed by a light lunch, which will be prepared by members of the host church and will be available free of charge. This Wednesday's service will be held at First Baptist Church. The service for March 11 will be held at First Presbyterian.
- **New Mid-Week Study for Adults:** A new adult study begins this Wednesday (March 4) as part of our Mid-Week ministry. In *Goliath Must Fall*, Pastor Louie Giglio talks about the "giants" in our lives (fear, anger, rejection, etc.) that cause us to lose sight of God's plan for victory. Using the story of David and Goliath, he shows how keeping our eyes on Jesus will cause Goliath to fall. The study runs through April 1, with March 11 off for the Spring Break of local schools.
