- Midday Worship for Lent: Calvary is joining First Baptist and First Presbyterian for a series of midday Lenten services. These services will be held every Wednesday at Noon and will rotate among all three churches. The brief time of worship and reflection will be followed by a light lunch, which will be prepared by members of the host church and will be available free of charge. This Wednesday's service will be held at First Baptist Church. The service for March 11 will be held at Fresbyterian.
