Church Life Updates

- Fifth Sunday: Next Sunday (March 31) is a 5th Sunday, which means that everyone is invited to make an extra contribution over and above their regular giving, which will be split equally between our Benevolence Fund (which meets emergency needs in our church family) and the Contingency Fund (which allows us to respond to unexpected ministry opportunities). Of course, you're always welcome to designate gifts to any fund you choose. Thank you for your faithful support of God's work here at Calvary.
- Easter Baskets for Franklin: Calvary has the opportunity to bless 20 students at Franklin Elementary whose families are facing financial hardship. We want to provide each child with some new spring clothes and an Easter basket, at an anticipated cost of \$40 to \$50 per child. We are seeking individuals, families, and Sunday School classes who would be willing to prepare baskets for these students.
