- Easter Missions: We're currently receiving our Easter Missions Offering, with a goal of \$3,000. To date we have received \$1,845.
- Easter Schedule: Mark your calendar so that you won't miss any of this year's Easter Celebration at Calvary. A Maundy Thursday service will be held on this Thursday, April 14, at 7 pm in the sanctuary. Easter Sunday will feature a Sunrise service at 7 am in the parking lot behind the church office (weather permitting), followed by Uplift at 8:30, a full Easter Breakfast at 9:15, Bible Study at 10, and the Traditional service at 10:55.
