- **Easter Sunrise:** Today's Easter Sunrise Service will begin at 6:45 at 459 Red Brush Road. Come welcome the rising sun...and the Risen Son who gives us life!
- **Easter Sunday:** Join the Calvary church family as we celebrate the resurrection of our Lord with an Easter breakfast at 8:30, Bible study at 9:30, and worship at 10:30. And after worship, don't miss this year's Easter Egg Hunt for the kids.
- **Easter Missions Offering:** As of last Sunday, we've raised \$2,380.77 toward our \$4000 goal.
