 brief business meeting to vote on a proposal to spend approximately
 \$100,050 on facility renovations. Of this amount, \$43.050 has already
 been designated for this purpose. So the finance committee seeks
 approval to spend up to \$65,000 from our General Operating Reserve.
- Anniversary Sunday and Offering: Next Sunday (May 7) Calvary will celebrate 110 years of serving Christ together! And because we want to highlight the one Lord and one faith that we share, we've decided to make our anniversary a "One Calvary" Sunday. As part of the occasion, we'll receive an anniversary offering that will help us to upgrade several entrance doors to provide greater security and enhanced accessibility.
