Church Life Updates

- **Welcome to Our Guest Speaker:** Sharing God's Word with us this morning in our pastor's absence is Dr. Rick Jordan. Rick has served as both a pastor and minister of education. He has numerous publications to his credit. And he has been the Church Resources Coordinator at Cooperative Baptist Fellowship of North Carolina since 2002. His responsibilities include coordinating ministries that equip lay persons. Rick is also President of Great Bible Teachers, a new ministry that "helps good Bible teachers become great Bible teachers." Rick and his wife, Susan, have been married since 1982. They have two grown sons. When he is not working or writing, he enjoys his square foot garden, Americana music, and hiking the Blue Ridge Mountains.
- **The End of "Island Visions":** Our pastor's summer sermon series on the Book of Revelation ends next Sunday with a focus on chapters 21 and 22. The Wednesday night Bible study on Revelation has already concluded and will not meet this week.
- **Deacon Nominations:** Next Sunday will be "Deacon Nomination Sunday," and Calvary members will have an opportunity to nominate to a 3-year term both men and women who are at least 21 years of age, who have been members of Calvary for at least two years, and who possess the qualities laid out in passages like Acts 6:3 and 1 Timothy 3:1-12.
