- Wednesday Night Activities: Calvary's Midweek Ministries begin this
 Wednesday night (Aug 23). Activities start each week at 6 pm with a
 brief time of prayer in the Fellowship Hall, followed by growth
 opportunities for all ages. Adults will have three study options.
 - Carol Lowe will lead a study on "Responding with Grace on Divisive Issues."
 - Becky Critz will lead "The Way of the Chosen," a study based on Season 3 of "The Chosen" TV series about the life of Jesus.
 - Pastor Alex will lead a study on "The Book of Revelation." (Note: This study will not begin until Wednesday, Sept. 6. It will be repeated each Thursday at 10 am, beginning Sept. 7)
