Church Life Updates

- **2022 Backpack Challenge:** In the month ahead, Calvary will once again serve students whose families face food insecurity through the Franklin Backpack program. But your support is essential! During September, we hope to raise \$5000 to fund this year's ministry, and you can participate by making sure that your check and/or envelope is marked "Backpack" or that you've selected "Franklin Backpack" as the designation for your online gift. In addition, we're seeking individuals who'd like to assist with shopping for supplies and/or packing the food. For more information on those opportunities, contact Pastor Alex.
- **Women in Mission** are going on a picnic! On September 6, the Women in Mission are going on a picnic at the Phillips' family cabin on the Blue Ridge Parkway. All women are invited. If you would like to go, meet at the church at 10:30 AM on Tuesday, September 6.
- **Youth Encounter:** Our Sunday night youth Encounter hangouts will start back on September 11th and will last from 5-6:30 each Sunday evening!
- **Deacon Selection Process:** This month, members of Calvary will have the opportunity to nominate the individuals from whom we will select new deacons to serve a 3-year term that begins in January of 2023. Nominees can be men or women who are at least 21 years of age, who've been members of Calvary for at least 2 years, and who passes the qualities described in passages like Acts 6:3, Romans 16:1, and 1 Timothy 3. Deacon nomination forms will be available in worship bulletins and church information centers on 9/11 and 9/18. Completed forms must be turned in at church no later than Sunday, September 9. The five most nominated individuals will be placed on this year's proposed slate of deacons, and we will vote by ballot to affirm these deacons on Sunday, October 9.
- **Wednesday Night Ministries:-** Our Mid-Week ministries will resume on September 14, and disciples of all ages are invited to join us for an evening of Bible study and fellowship. Activities start at 6 pm and end at 7:15. A nursery is available for youngest children. *Mission Friends* is for 4-5 year olds. *Explorers* is for our 1st-5th graders, and youth will meet as well! Adults have two study options: "*Never Too Late*"—a study about encouraging faith in your adult children led by Becky Critz—and "*Jumping into the General Epistles*"—a study of those lesser-known letters in the New Testament led by Pastor Alex.
