# Church Life Updates

- **Kids' Christmas Musical:** Our children's choir will begin rehearsals for the Christmas musical on TONIGHT (Oct. 1) from 6-6:45 PM. All ages are welcome!
- **JOY Luncheon:** The JOY group will meet for lunch at 13 Bones restaurant this Wednesday, Oct. 4 at 12 noon. Please plan to join us!
- **Mid-Week Growth Opportunities:** The study of "Moses - In the Footsteps of a Reluctant Prophet" continues this week. Also, in the Healthy Families forum, Lilnette Phillips of SECU will discuss strategies for developing a family budget and making good financial decisions. Join us for snack supper at 5:45 and classes for all ages begin at 6:15 p.m. This week, the snack supper will be hosted by Youth Adults SS class and they will serve tacos.
- **Dinner Theatre:** Thanks to all who have signed up to go see Ragtime at the Wohlfahrt House on Thursday, October 5. We will leave Calvary at 10am. Please have a check payable to Calvary Baptist for \$38, and designate it for JOY group.
- **Movie Night:** Calvary will sponsor a free showing of "The Case for Christ" on Sunday, October 8, at 6:30 PM. The movie tells the story of journalist Lee Strobel, who set out to disprove Christianity but came to faith instead. It's a great way to learn more about the evidence for faith; so why not invite a friend? Popcorn & drinks will be provided.
- **Feed the Hunger Packathon:** On Saturday, October 21, Calvary will host a "Feed the Hunger Packathon" from 10 AM to Noon. With your help, we plan to pack 12,000 to 15,000 meals (consisting of dried rice, beans, and vegetables), which will be distributed to people in desperate need through Christian orphanages and relief agencies. But to make the event a success, we need your help in two key ways:
  - Give:** Most of the money need to pay for the food and shipping costs will come from our mission budget. But we will need \$500 to cover the cost for the minimum number of meals, which is 12,000. Of course, we'd like to do *more* than the minimum; our goal is 15,000 meals. But to supply this much food, we'll need to raise a total of \$1400. You can help us meet this goal by making a financial gift and marking it "Packathon," or by contributing to our children's "Penny Drive" when you come to church on October 7 and 14.
  - Volunteer:** On the October 21, we'll need between 75 and 100 volunteers to pack and label meals – and to keep our packing stations stocked. You can register by placing your name on the sign-up sheet located on the bulletin board outside the nursery, or you can call the church office.
- **Blood Drive Results:** The recent blood drive collected 40 pints of blood. Thanks to everyone willing to give and for Co-Ed 4's help in a successful drive!
