# Church Life Updates

- **Healthy Lifestyles:** This Wednesday (Oct. 11), we conclude our healthy families forum with a visit from a health specialist of Northern Hospital who will offer insights about making healthy food choices and incorporating a proper diet and exercise into a healthy lifestyle.
- **New Mid-Week Study Options:** Wednesday, October 18 begins a new session of our Mid-Week Ministry, and adults have two new study options from which to choose. "The Case for Christ" uses Bible study and clips from the movie to provide deeper understanding about the evidence for faith. "Address the Mess" features teaching from Andy Stanley and helps us see how even the "messes" in our lives (professional, relational, financial) can move us closer to God. A snack supper is served at 5:45, and studies for all ages begin at 6:15.
- **Box Tops for Education:** The BYW is collecting Box Tops for Education and Labels for Education to be taken to Cedar Ridge School. This school was chosen because it is in a less-populated area and, therefore, often receives less community support. Just drop your Box Tops and Labels in the box on the table between the sanctuary and classroom area. Thank you for helping our children!
