Cari and Andy Robertson have made some major changes concerning their ministry in Africa. Tony will be starting high school at Rift Valley Academy in Kenya. The family decided that it would best meet his needs to be a station student and live with his parents. The goal would be to help Tony adjust to the academic expectations and integrate socially. If the goal is met, Cari and Andy would be in Kenya for a year and return to Chad for the remainder of their term.

As Rift Academy is an AIM supported school, this will just be a change of assignment. Both will use their talents at Rift Academy with Cari being a high school English teacher and Andy a physician for the student health team. Their mission of Christ centered churches among all African people will not change. The Robertsons ask for prayers that Tony will adjust and thrive, and that they can be back in Chad in July, 2023.
