





Coming Soon to a Pulpit Near You:

It's been several months since many of you here at Calvary shared with me your input for summer sermon topics. Sadly, there aren't enough Sundays in the summer to address all the excellent issues you raised. But I do hope that the messages inspired by your suggestions have provided food for thought and fuel for growth.

As we conclude the summer, there are two more issues you raised that I hope we can address. Several of you noted how angry, hateful, and violent our world has become; and you asked, "Why does the world have to be so mean?" Others wondered what we can expect when the world is healed: "What will heaven be like? And why doesn't Jesus just come back and take us there?"

Budget Planning to Begin




