

This Month: "One Calvary" Sunday

"Make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace.

There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called to one hope when you were called; one Lord, one faith, one baptism; one God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all." (Ephesians 4:3-6)

Participating in the life of a church like Calvary presents an important challenge. We offer two different worship gatherings— contemporary at 8:30 and traditional at 11:00. And even though that's a good thing (because it lets us reach more people with a wider array of needs), it's all-too-easy for us to be part of the same church family without ever meeting our brothers and sisters in Christ! But as this passage from Ephesians reminds us, we're still one church. And we're called to "make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace."

That's why, this year, we plan to cultivate our unity with a handful of special celebrations that we're calling "One Calvary" Sundays. On each "One Calvary" Sunday—the first of which will take place on February 19, with others following on July 30, October 29, and December 31—we'll follow a special schedule that features a church family breakfast from 8:45 to 9:25, Sunday School from 9:30 to 10:25, and one shared time of worship from 10:30 to 11:30.

Of course, we want everyone to understand that we're not doing this in order to "inconvenience" anyone by tinkering with their Sunday morning routine. Nor are we trying to deprive anyone of the worship experience they're accustomed to by blending our different worship traditions! But we do feel our unity is so vital that it will be more than worth it to create these times together, so that we can truly have "One Lord...One Faith...One Calvary!"

"One Calvary" Sunday is coming soon on February 19! We hope you can join us as we celebrate the unity that is our as the family of God.

A New Kind of Directory

The last several years have produced a lot of change at Calvary. Old friends have left us to pursue new callings or to take up their place in the Church Triumphant. And new friends have joined us to become part of the church family through which God continues to work. And as a result, we're overdue to create a new church directory—something that can help us

get to know one another and keep in touch with each other between the times that we're together.

But as many of you know: Church directories can be a hassle! If we use a directory service, everyone has to deal with the inconvenience of scheduling a photo shoot and the pressure of resisting a photo sales pitch. And if we Church Directory™ can access the directory on your phone or tablet. produce a directory "in house," we still need to collect photos and enter data—all to produce a directory that begins to become outdated almost as soon as its printed.

Thankfully, there are some new approaches to directory creation. And that's why Calvary is pleased to announce our "First-Ever, Cloud-Based, Continuously-Updated, BYOP (Bring-Your-Own-Photo) Directory!" Of course, if that sounds a bit confusing—it's really not. But please allow us to explain...

Beginning this month, we'll be moving our directory online through "InstantChurchDirectory.com". As a part of our church family, you'll be able to visit this website, create your own login, sign-in to the website, and update all your information...including your photo!

"But hold on," you might say. "What if I don't 'do technology' - or what if I don't want to create an online profile?" No problem! We'll have good-old-fashioned information update cards here at church that you can use to update your information. And you can provide us with a photo (digital or hard-copy) that we can upload for you. We'll even have a photographer (our own Debbie Howlett) on-hand for several upcoming Sundays so that you can get a photo taken (at no charge) if you don't already have one you like.

> As everyone gets their photos and information updated, there will be several different ways that you can access the church directory. You can login to your "InstantChurchDirectory" account and view the directory online. You can download the "Church Directory Mobile App," so that you You can print a hardcopy directory for yourself. Or

- especially for those who don't "do technology" - we'll print hard copy directories for those who need or want them.

There are several advantages to this approach. Members of our church family can update their directory information—including their photo—any time they wish. No one has to deal with the scheduling or cost issues of a traditional directory service. And with a little bit of help from you, we can make sure that we always have an accurate and up -to-date directory to share with everyone who's part of our church family!

We'll be letting you know how to get started with your "Instant Church Directory" membership in the near future. But for now, please be looking for that perfect family picture you can share with others. And please be listening for more information as we help you learn how get connected to others in our church family.






"Divided We Stand"
