Sermons for the Season of Lent: Kingdom 101

According to both Matthew and Mark, Jesus inaugurated his public ministry by announcing, "The kingdom of God has come near! Change your life and believe the good news!" And from that moment on, his message about the kingdom persuaded some to put their trust in him, while it led others to condemn him. Of course, we still pray, "Thy kingdom come; they will be done on earth as it is in heaven." But what exactly are we praying for when we make that request? What does it mean for us to desire the kingdom? And what can we expect to happen in us and through us as the kingdom continues to come near?

Bulletin Board Fundraiser



Calvary's New Directory (In Print, Online, or On Your Phone!)

We're in the process of producing our next church directory...and we need your help! If you haven't already done so, please visit "InstantChurchDirectory.com" and click on "Member Sign In." When you're directed to the login page, select the button that says, "First time signing in? Create Login." This will take you to a page where you can enter the



email address that our church has on file for you and where you can create and confirm a password. When you hit "Submit," you'll be sent a verification email. And once you respond to that message, you'll be able to update your information and upload a photo of yourself or your family.

Please note: 1) You can also create your account using the "Instant Church Directory" app that you can download to your phone or mobile device from your carrier's app store. And 2) if we don't have an email address on file for you, you'll have to send that information to Pastor Alex before you can create a directory account.

Of course, if you prefer not to use these digital tools, you can also update your directory entry the old fashioned way, by completing a "Directory Information Card" (available in the sanctuary lobby) and returning it to the church office. Then, you can email a photo to Pastor Alex—or listen for the dates that Debbie Howlett will be available to take your photo during Sunday morning church activities.

We hope to complete the update process by Easter. Then, you'll be able to access our directory anytime by using the Instant Church Directory website or app—or by reserving a print copy. If you have any questions, please contact the church office.
