Church Life Updates

- **Ash Wednesday:** The season of Lent begins on Wednesday, March 5, and Calvary invites you to start the season by participating in a special time of worship called “The Seven Symbols of Ash.” Using interactive prayer stations, worshipers will meditate on some of the lessons that ashes can teach. But to allow everyone to consider these lessons at their own pace, the service will be “self-guided.” Beginning at 4 o’clock and running until 7 o’clock, the sanctuary will be open, and Pastor Alex will be present to get you started, so that you can pray for as little time (or as much time) as you need. We hope you can join us, and—as an added incentive—those who participate will receive a devotional guide for Lent that will help you continue your preparation for Easter.
- **Faith, Fun and Fellowship:** We will be meeting on Wednesday March 5th at 11:00 am for an old-fashioned potluck and hen party. You are all invited to bring a dish to share and come fellowship together.
- **March Mission Project:** This month, we’re inviting you to bless others by providing bags of essential toiletry items for students in need in local schools. If you, your family, or your Sunday School class would like to prepare a bag or bags, please contact Jan Varney to receive a list of the items to include in it. Based on our “shopping reconnaissance,” each bag will cost approximately \$15 to \$18. Completed bags should be returned to the church no later than March 23.
- **Mark Your Calendar:** Our final session of Midweek Ministry for spring will begin on Wednesday, March 19! Among the adult growth options there will be a study about finding power in prayer, led by David McPeak. Also, on Saturday, March 22, you’re invited to a Pancake Breakfast sponsored by the Surry Baptist Men. The event will take place in Calvary’s fellowship hall between 7 am and 10 am. All proceeds will support the Handyman Ministry.
- **Ministry Opportunity:** The AV Team is seeking volunteers who can help advance worship slides during the traditional service. Volunteers do not need any special computer knowledge; and if you can press a button, you can serve in this important way.
