Church Life Updates

- **March Mission Project:** If you agreed to fill a “blessing bag” with hygiene products for students in local schools, please remember that completed bags are due back at church today (Sunday, March 22).
- **Midweek Adult Study:** This Wednesday, March 25, there will not be a meeting of the adult Bible study being led by Pastor Alex. That study will conclude the following Wednesday, April 1. And then, after Easter, adults are invited to join us on Wednesday nights for a discussion group as part of our “Practicing the Way” emphasis.
- **Easter Offering:** Help us share the good news about the resurrection life available in Jesus by supporting our Easter Missions Offering!
- This allows Calvary to partner with missionaries who are on the front line of God’s kingdom work. Our goal for this offering is \$4000. and heading into today, you’ve contributed \$1,265.
- **Palm Sunday:** Although next Sunday, March 29, is a fifth Sunday, we will not follow our “One Calvary” combined schedule. Instead, we’ll follow our normal schedule with contemporary worship at 8:30, Sunday School at 9:45, and traditional worship at 10:55. The Lord’s Supper will be shared in both services.
- **Good Friday Service:** Calvary will host a brief Tenebrae Service (or “Service of Darkness” at 6:30 in the evening on Good Friday, April 3. We invite you to join us for prayer, song, and a candlelit journey through the story of the cross as we remember what Jesus endured to reconcile us to God.
- **Own a Piece of Calvary History:** In conjunction with Calvary’s 100th anniversary celebration, church members were given the opportunity to purchase limited edition prints and pewter ornaments depicting our church buildings. One of our members has had to “clear out” these items to make room for other things. So if you’d like to acquire a print or an ornament, please speak to the pastor. Any contribution you make will support the Handyman ministry.
