## Church Life Updates

- **March Mission:** Thanks to your faithfulness and generosity, 100 hygiene bags were delivered to local schools to bless students in need.
- **Faith, Fun & Fellowship:** Join us this Wednesday, April 1, for an “April Fool’s” Social! Wear your pajamas and bring a breakfast side for our breakfast food potluck (church will provide fruit tray, along with gravy and biscuits). And plan now for our bus trip to Kernersville on Wednesday, April 15 to see the Paul J. Ciener Botanical Garden. We’ll meet at church at 9:30 that day. Bring some money for lunch at the Route 66 Diner in Kernersville.
- **Good Friday Service:** Calvary will host a brief Tenebrae Service (or “Service of Darkness” at 6:30 pm on Good Friday, April 3. We invite you to join us for prayer, song, and a candlelit journey through the story of the cross as we remember what Jesus endured to reconcile us to God.
- **Celebrate Resurrection:** Praise God for the gift of new life in Christ on Easter Sunday! Our Sunrise Service will begin at 7am at 459 Red Brush Road and will be followed by an Easter Breakfast at 8:30, Sunday School at 9:30, at 10:30 featuring “Risen King” (a choir and praise band cantata), and a children’s Easter Egg Hunt after worship.
- **Easter Offering:** Help us share the good news about the resurrection life available in Jesus by supporting our Easter Missions Offering! This allows Calvary to partner with missionaries who are on the front line of God’s kingdom work. Our goal for this offering is \$4000. and heading into today, you’ve contributed \$1860.
