Church Life Updates

- **One Calvary Sunday:** Today is “One Calvary Sunday.” And so, we thank you for being with us as we celebrate our unity as a church family. As is our custom, we’re receiving a special offering today for our Benevolence Fund. If you’d like to help us to respond to emergency needs within our church family, we invite you consider prayerfully how you’d like to participate.
- **Connecting in “Faith, Fun & Fellowship”:** April’s fellowship gathering will take place in the fellowship hall this Wednesday (April 2) at 11 am. We’ll be playing a guessing game to get better acquainted. And so we ask you to jot down some “little known facts” about yourself, so that we can guess which facts go with which person. Refreshments will be provided, and everyone is invited!
- **April Mission: Blessing New Life:** This month, we’ll be supporting the work of *The Legacy Center*, our local crisis pregnancy ministry. We’re collecting baby wipes, diapers (sizes 3, 4 and 5), and new infant clothes (sizes 2T and 3T). If you, your family, or your class would like to do something more substantial, you can also team up to provide a new car seat, stroller, or crib. Collection boxes will be available, beginning next week.
- **Easter Missions Offering:** Help us share the good news of life in Jesus by supporting our Easter Missions Offering. Our goal this year is \$4000. You can designate your gift to Andy & Cari Robertson (our missionaries to central Africa), the Annie Armstrong Offering (SBS), or the Global Missions Offering (CBF).

Led by Dave McPeak, we’ll be learning *about* prayer and participating *in* prayer.
