# Church Life Updates

- **A “Back to School” Blessing:** We’re looking for Sunday School classes, families, and/or individuals who will bless a student in need at Franklin Elementary School by purchasing a back-to-school outfit and/or other supplies. To sponsor a child, complete a purple registration card from the sanctuary lobby and drop it in the offering or return it to the church office.
- **Praying Our Way Beyond Normal:** As we emerge from the disruptions of the past year, we want to be intentional about seeking God’s will for our church and its ministries.
