On Sunday, October 19, the Calvary family will suspend our *worship services*, so that we can *worship through serving!* We're planning a range of ministry projects that require many different skills and gifts. So we encourage you to look over the list below; and if you see one in which you'd like to participate, please sign-up by using the bulletin tear-off.

- "Beauty of Holiness" Bunch: Bring joy to residents at Colonial Care by providing haircuts and nail painting.
- Blessing Box Team: Meet needs by restocking local blessing boxes with food, clothing, and other supplies.
- Calvary Welcome Wagon: Prepare "outreach bags" that can be used by Calvary members to invite friends, clients, and folks who are new to our community to worship with us.
- Card Ministry: Bless members of our church and community by creating cards and writing notes of encouragement.
- Care for the Incarcerated: Pack and deliver care packages filled with personal care items for inmates of the Surry County Jail.
- Christmas in October: Fill 120 backpacks that will be distributed to students at Mount Park Elementary School as part of the Surry Baptist Association's Christmas Backpack ministry.
- **The Construction Crew**: Bless a local family in need by providing a ramp or other home improvements.
- The "Fun with Fidgets" Folks: Use your sewing skills to prepare fidget blankets that will be minister to individuals dealing with memory issues.
- "Holy Comforter" Knitting Group: Make lap blankets for local nursing homes and victims of flooding in Western NC.
- **Homebound Blessing Team**: Share visits with Calvary's homebound members while delivering lunch.
- The Lunch Bunch: Prepare and deliver the lunch that will be served to all of our Servant Sunday participants
- **Paul Bunyan Brigade**: Join us for a morning of wood-splitting, as we make sure that local friends in need have wood to heat their homes this winter.
- Road Redemption Project: Serve Calvary's neighbors and beautify our community by collecting trash along South Franklin Road.
- **The School Squad**: Put your gardening, yardwork, and prayer skills to good use by doing a project at and prayer walk at Tharrington, Gentry and NSHS.
- "Senior Sunshine" Project: Prepare fall door decorations for the residents at Twelve Oaks Assisted Living.

- **Singing for the Saints**: Kids and other "young at heart" volunteers will spread joy by singing for and visiting with residents of local nursing homes.
- Team Snack Attack: Prepare and deliver snack packages for hospital staff and waiting rooms.
- Yokefellow Cleaning Crew: Help our local food bank meet the needs of hungry families by cleaning and arranging the food storage area.

#### **New This Year!**

In addition to our other projects, we're expanding *Servant Sunday* this year to make it a "*Servant Week*." While details are still being worked out, we plan to offer several projects that you can help us tackle between Monday, Oct. 20 and Saturday, Oct. 25. These include:

- The Soup Group: Make homemade soup for our homebound members.
- **Hygiene Packathon**: In partnership with "Feed the Hunger," a NC-based ministry that provides vital relief supplies around the world, we will be packing almost 1500 hygiene bags that include a toothbrush, soap, washcloth, and band-aids.
- Hurricane Helpers: Make a one-day, two-day, or three-day trip to Ashe County to help with ongoing Hurricane Helene recovery efforts. Volunteers of all skill levels (or no skill levels) will be needed. And for those who want more than one day of serving, lodging is available at a local campsite that provides beds along with toilet and shower facilities.

Please begin praying now about how you'd like to serve. And who knows? Maybe God will lay on your heart another project that would allow us to be a blessing to others.
