Church Life Updates

- Christmas Missions Offering: Thank you for sharing the love of Christ with people around the world! Heading into this Sunday, we have collected \$5,010 toward our goal for this year of \$6000.
- Christmas Eve: You and your family are invited to join us for a service of Christmas Eve worship on Tuesday, December 24 at 5:30 PM.
- Youth Jamaica Mission: On December 27, a team of 16 students and 8 adults from Calvary will set off for Jamaica on the mission trip that was postponed due to dangerous weather last summer. They'll spend a week serving with Pastor Wayne Smith of Greenwood Baptist Church through Praying Pelican Ministries. Please be sure to pray for the team's safety, ministry, and growth in Christ. And pray, too, for the people whose hearts they'll touch. The team will return on January 3.
- One Calvary Sunday: Next Sunday, December 29, will be our final "One Calvary Sunday" for 2024.
